SUMMARY OF CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY PROJECTS APPROVED BY THE COMPANY FOR FY26-27

Sr. No.	Company's CSR Initiative	Details
1.	Developing and Desilting Water Reservoirs Project	Rejuvenation and desiltation of existing water bodies in water-stressed regions of Maharashtra improved groundwater levels, reduced soil erosion and enabled enhanced agricultural productivity. This large-scale initiative focuses on excavation, deepening, and development of traditional and existing water bodies to restore their storage capacity, improve water percolation, and ensure year-round availability of water. The work is being carried out in close partnership with the Government of Maharashtra's Water and Soil Conservation Department and the NAAM Foundation, by leveraging the Gal Mukh Dharan and Gal Yukt Shivar scheme. The proposal anticipates excavation and rejuvenation of 84 larger water bodies across Ahilyanagar, Pune, Palghar and Buldhana districts, with an estimated beneficiary reach of over 80,000 villagers.
2.	Maa ki Roti	As part of our work in women's empowerment and nutrition, 'Ma Ki Roti' is based on a two-pronged approach designed to address nutrition as well as women livelihood. 'Ma Ki Roti' is primarily a community health kitchen managed by a women's group who prepare the meals and makes them available to surrounding laborers, migrants and Drivers. These are affordable meals at ₹10 to those in need. Group members earn a sustained livelihood for themselves, in addition to receiving food for themselves and family members. As part of the project, two community kitchens had been made operational, providing subsidized meals to urban laborers and migrant populations.
3.	The Women Entrepreneurship Project	The Women Entrepreneurship Project aimed to strengthen and upgrade existing five skill centers across tribal villages in Palghar, training more than 175 women from Self Help in tailoring and embroidery. The Model was already in place by Ram Krishna Mission wherein the money flowed to the community.
4.	Convergence Project - Integrated Village Development Project 2.0	The Convergence Model is implemented in partnership with the State Administration to create exponential, scalable, sustainable and replicable impact. Under this Model, the government system served as the primary financier through the government schemes, TML facilitates in leveraging these schemes for community members and village development, focusses on capacity building and community ownership, thus ensuring long-term sustainability. The IVDP 2.0 had been implemented in partnership with the District Administration, Maharashtra, covering 82 Gram Panchayats across 12 districts. The Programme had facilitated service delivery through Helpdesks, health kits, solar installations, seed distribution and civil works, reaching ~2.15

		lakh individuals, strengthening Panchayati Raj planning and governance mechanisms.
5.	Construction for Zilla Parishad School	The Project is in collaboration with Bombay Mothers & Children Welfare Society and improved facilities for 120 students, including construction of the first-floor construction at the Jalindernagar Tribal School.
6.	Construction in Zilla Parishad School, Pangari	The Zilla Parishad School in Pangari was in a critical condition, with broken cement sheet roofing causing water leakage and the entry of snakes, thereby creating unsafe conditions for students. It is proposed to construct four classrooms, one hall, toilets, and steps, covering a total area of 3,755 sq.ft., at a total project cost of ₹62,03,460 through The Bombay Mothers and Children Welfare Society.
