SUMMARY OF CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY PROJECTS APPROVED BY THE COMPANY

Sr. No.	Company's CSR Initiative	Details
1.	Tree Plantation	Plantation of fruit and forestry saplings in Palghar district. A proposal involved improving the quality of life of Tribals in Palhar District by providing sustainable livelihood options and transforming waste land. The initiatives focus on livelihood and water which are perennial issues.
2.	Project Bench	Project Bench is a 'Best from Waste' concept. The Company would provide benches to school for under privileged children around Pune. Benches would be made from wood the Company received as packaging material used during transportation of vehicle kits.
3.	Project Pradnya	Project 'Pradnya' is aimed at enriching the lives of underprivileged children who do not have access to mainstream education. Employees at the Pune Plant would dedicate some time to share knowledge and information with the underprivileged children and support them in their learning. Digital initiatives under Pradnya would provide e-learning tools to school to enable better education access to the underprivileged children.
4.	Jalindernager Tribal School Project	Jalindernager Tribal School is located in a remote tribal area with a spread of 1.5 acrea area of land. The Company would address the growing need of the students as the strength of the students expanded from 8 to 120 students, as on date and provide electronic devices, utilities, learning & school aids and additional resources on requirement basis.
5.	Gorthan Lab Project	Gorthan Lab Project focused on a Zilla Parishad School in Gorthan village within the Jawhar Block, of Palghar district. The school served five adjoining hamlets located on hills, with significant dropout rates, especially among girls. The project aimed to construct a state of art school with 3 classrooms, kitchen, wash area, playground, sewage, and electrical fittings. The initiative would provide access to quality education and infrastructure and reduce drop-out rate.
6.	Self Help Groups – Empowering Women Entrepreneur Project	The self-help groups created sustainable livelihoods for tribal women and youth, focusing on SC/ST communities, girls, persons with disabilities, single parents, and widows. The groups would initiate 10 small-scale business ventures such as agarbatti, fish farming, nursery, and vermicelli groups.
7.	Maa ki Roti Project	Maa ki Roti Project in Pune is involved in a community health kitchen managed by women preparing affordable meals at ₹10 for needy people. Each group member earned an average of ₹2000-₹2500 per month, in addition to having food for themselves and family members costing ₹500- ₹800 per month. Through this project, te Company would contribute for two kitchens.
8.	Early Detection of Cervical Cancer Project	Project on the early detection of cervical cancer, collaborating with the Vishwanath Cancer Care Foundation, Indian Cancer Society, and Karkinos Healthcare. The Project aimed to design a program for early detection of cervical cancer in Karnataka, screening 8000 eligible women for HPV DNA Testing.
